Town Initiatives- Snapshot

Undergrounding- The next monthly update to the Town Commission is scheduled for December 10th. The Town is negotiating a contract with the Design Build firm and has meet with the selected private partners for the fiber, wireless, and cell coverage enhancements. A term sheet with the private partners will be brought to the Commission. Work is expected to start on the undergrounding early 2019.

Colony Demolition- All of the buildings are now down. The developer is removing the debris from the site and also demolishing other portions of the property separate from the Town's Emergency Order.

Ringling Arts, Cultural and Education Center- the Town has selected a demolition contractor to remove the old Amore Restaurant. This is the first step in creating a temporary outdoor venue for the site in advance of the funding raising for the new facility.

Non-Conforming Properties Redevelopment- the Commission has requested a follow-up discussion on proposed changes to the Town's code regarding redevelopment of non-conforming properties at their December 10th Regular Workshop.

Coyote Presentation- the Town is hosting two presentations by The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC). They will be help on December 17th. One in the morning and one in the afternoon. See upcoming events below for times and locations.

2019 Citizen's Academy- Look for the announcement. Classes will start on January 9 2019 and the program is scheduled for Wednesday mornings over a 6 week period.
